Apprenticeship – Increased FTE through career pathways and new courses:

Implemented five different trades serving approximately 80-100 students. **91.07 FTE generated** (and associated tuition and fees; does not include students enrolled in other departments). Promoted three (3) degree pathways resulting in increased numbers of students in pipeline to complete degrees (10) and certificates (50).
