

## Coop Ed 2009-10

### Accomplishment Description:

**Co-op Ed -- Three new co-op courses offered at the 180 level:** Youth and low income adults were eligible to enroll in these new courses in the areas of sustainability, industrial and health. **58 students enrolled** at an average of **2 credits of co-op** each for a **total of 6.5 FTE**.
