ultrasonic cleaner: replace broken unit \$2,700.00

#### dental units:

- 1. add electrical plugs and ultrasonic hook-ups for water and electrical to three lab units \$1,800.00
- 2. Purchase portable dental unit and chair for community dental health activities \$5,000.00

**dental lab equipment:** upgrade older equipment and furbish facility with state of the art small equipment for dental materials and procedures \$4,000.00

stools: purchase 6 new stools to replace worn out and broken stools for operators \$3,500

radiology chairs: replace 1 broken chair \$1,500.00

manikins: repair teeth and mechanisms and purchase instructional manikins for dental hygiene instrumentation \$4,000

**computers:** replace 6 laptops \$6,000.00 add scanners to facility for transition to paperless dental records \$2,500.00
