Computer Lab/Classroom Paper and Toner supplies

Summary:

Provide printing supplies for 62 IT supported computer labs and classrooms on the main campus and at the Downtown Center, Airport, and the Cottage Grove branch.

Description

This initiative will provide funding to supply printing supplies to 62 IT supported computer labs and classrooms on the main campus, and at the Downtown Center, Airport, and Cottage Grove branch for the entire 2011-2012 fiscal year, based on existing printing limits and standards. Last year's funding is fulfilling the needs of the Instructional Computing labs currently supported. The outcome expected from funding this year would be the ability to provide all the paper and toner needed for all of these labs and classrooms for this coming fiscal year.

This request is a recurring cost. Paper and toner costs in IT supported computer labs have always been funded by Student Technology Fees. This initiative ensures that Lane's students have the paper and toner supplies available for their printing needs in 62 of Lane's computer labs and classrooms.

Describe the resources needed:

Students utilize ICL supported computer open labs and classrooms to take classes and do their homework. They need printing supplies to print out their work for submission, to print their research documents, syllabi, schedules, and other school related materials. This funding would provide enough paper and toner to adequately supply 62 of these computer labs and classrooms. Specifically, these funds will provide approximately 175 toner cartridges and 300 cases of paper.

175 toner cartridges (M&S) \$26,250.00

300 cases of paper (M&S) \$9,000.00

Request: Technology Fee (M&S) \$35,250.00
