Description

Library/T2T Merger

We will reorient the T2T program to focus on Digital Literacy in Higher Education, which will work in tandem with the Library's Information Literacy mission. This realignment will broaden our scope to enable a more effective exploration of pedagogy and technology, to align curriculum, and to address new technologies and audiences. The scope of the Library's mission fits perfectly with that of T2T, i.e. campus wide service, integration, and support throughout all programs, departments, and courses.

Online High School Pathways

In partnership with Lane ESD and the High School Connections office, Academic Technology is creating virtual pathways between the Lane ESD Online program and the Lane CC Online program. This includes consulting on Moodle development for Lane ESD, provisioning of T2T training for College Now faculty, and development of a professional development program for online pedagogy designed for secondary educators.
