Teaching & Best Practices: The In addition, faculty led a summer workshop for 20+ faculty on integrating “On Course” principles into course syllabi. LLC Faculty worked with colleagues across the college to create a number of Learning Communities, highly integrated course sets that help students integrate skills and information from two or more content areas while attending classes as a cohort. Faculty also taught in First Year Experience and Fast Lane courses.
