Online Library Resources: Databases

Summary:

Maintain support for library online resources for general education, online learning, and career and technical programs.

Description

Providing online information resources for students is a major library goal. It is our ongoing objective to make the best use of the library's budget, and to optimize access to library resources. Accordingly, the Library continues to select and monitor its electronic holdings to provide access to students anytime, anywhere.

Providing online aggregated databases is an extremely efficient and effective way to give access to a wealth of information. A database of e-books, for example, requires no weeding, selection, or circulation processing of individual items. Use of online library resources increased by 200% last year, and online resources are becoming the backbone of all academic libraries.

This funding initiative includes provision of access to online instructional support resources such as:

- Online reference sources and general periodical databases
- Online resources for Career and Technical Education students, including Automotive Reference Center, CINAHL, Nursing Journals and Nursing Reference Center, Construction Technology, Dental Hygiene and Dental Assisting, Adult Development and Aging, Computer Information Technology, and more.
- Online library resources for General Education, faculty and staff. Databases include Academic Search Premier, SIRS Knowledge Base, Opposing Viewpoints, Register Guard online, African American Experience, Literature Resource Center, and many more.
- E-book collection that supports both CTE and Liberal Education programs.
