Summary:

Bring equipment up to current standards for smart classrooms, and replace worn-out task chairs.

Description

The Library's instructional equipment is several generations behind current standards, and the Bond project completion is years away. We should not continue to defer this maintenance. In addition to podium resources, we need a digital screen instead of a projector system. This will allow us to broadcast instructional messages to students when we are not actively teaching.

Classroom chairs must be replaced because they are filthy and students are beginning to regard them as health hazards.

Last year the Library provided instruction for 5,583 student in 283 individual class sessions. This number reflects a growth of instruction requests that began building before our dramatic increase in enrollment.
