An initiative request for funding of a part-time position in the Social Science Testing Lab resulted in a re-allocation of time sheet funds for additional help in the lab. The funding will help to serve students, providing them an opportunity to take tests when they are fully prepared and at an optimal time for them. The lab serves the entire campus, with the bulk of the testing being for distance learning and courses outside of Social Science. Both Career Technical and Transfer Programs make use of the Testing Lab.
