History Faculty 1.0 FTE Position

Summary:

Request of a 1.0 FTE History Position in Social Science, supports the department's goals of:

- Assisting students in transferring to other college and universities.
- Helping students communicate effectively, think critically and solve problems creatively.
- Increase understanding of the relationships between self and community.

Description

History classes are fully enrolled with students frequently on a waiting list. It is becoming more difficult to find part time instructors to meet student demand. Unfortunately, classes need to be cut if a part-time instructor cannot be identified. Four hundred and fifty students would benefit annually from this initiative.

This initiative has been included in all prior unit plans since Unit Planning became a yearly expectation at Lane Community College. Having a much needed full-time faculty position would better serve students and the department. When we went from 3-4 credit classes the number of sections offered decreased. We implemented that plan and find that our classes are more than full this year. Another full-time faculty member in history would enhance that productivity by allowing us to add more classes and raise student FTE.

- Contribute to students' ability to apply course knowledge and skills to their personal, social, and professional lives.

The methods we would use to determine the outcomes would be:

- Assessing our history students for their perceptions of what they have learned and how they might apply the knowledge they gained in our courses.
- Checking with enrollment services, IRAP, and counseling in order to keep track of our students.
