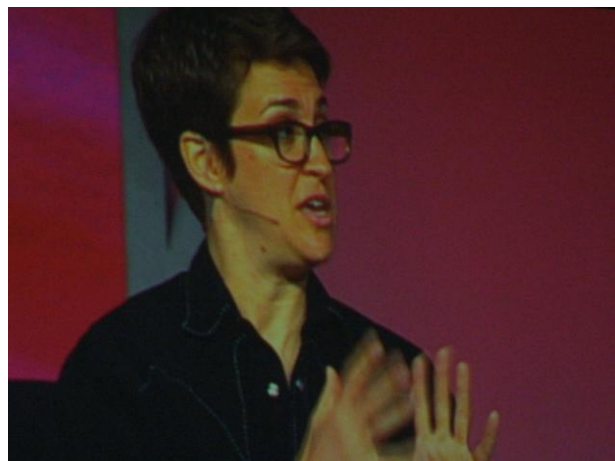

Last month the Sigma Zeta chapter voted to elect new officers for the upcoming year. "And the winners are..."

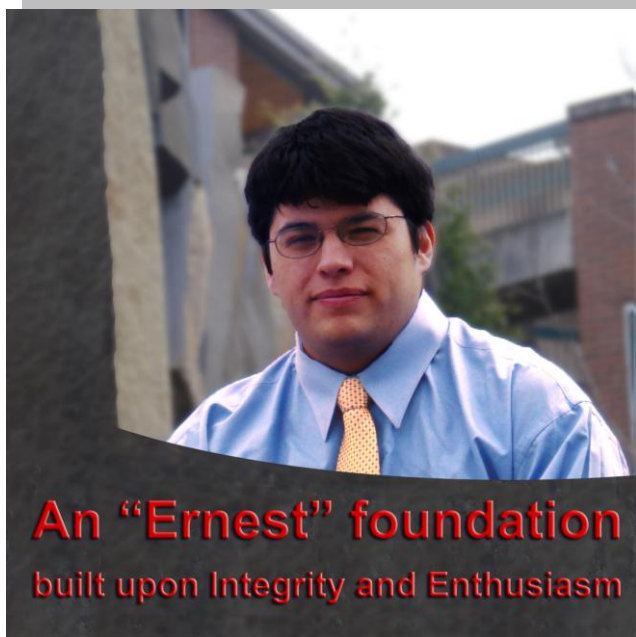

Matthew Ray for Regional President (CEO)

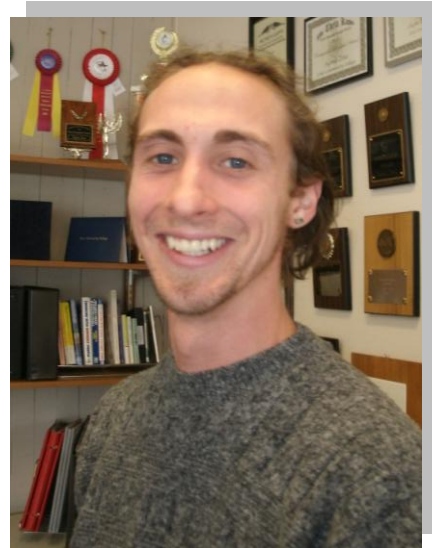
