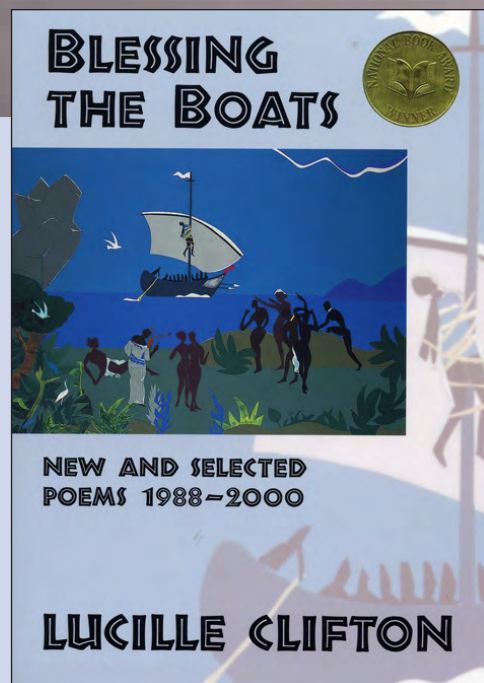


# Lane Community College's Reading Together Project Presents Lucille Clifton
