*Only the Brave* is a searing portrait of war and prejudice, which takes the viewer on a haunting journey into the hearts and minds of the forgotten heroes of World War II – the all-volunteer, Japanese-American 100th/442nd Regimental Combat Team. During two years of combat, their extraordinary valor resulted in an unparalleled 21 Medals of Honor, 9486 Purple Hearts, eight Presidential Citations, 53 Distinguished Service Crosses, 588 Silver Stars and 5200 Bronze Star Medals – making them the most decorated unit of their size and length of service in American military history. Outstanding among their many exploits was the rescue of the Texas 36<sup>th</sup> Division, despite decimation of their own ranks.

Come that evening to the opening night gala presentation of the entire film at the DisOrient Asian-American Film Festival, Bijou Art Cinema, 5:45 pm and 8:25 pm.
