
Key Benchmarks -- LANE Community College

College Now Students Enrolled in Credit Courses (not College Now) 1-year Later



- Number of College Now Seniors Enrolled Next Academic Year in Lane Credit Classes
- Percent of College Now Seniors Enrolled Next Academic Year in Lane Credit Classes
- ◆ During the 2007-08 academic year, 1,155 high school seniors were enrolled in College Now courses. From those students, 731 were enrolled in Lane credit courses (not College Now courses) one year later during the 2008-09 academic year.

Analysis and Action: The number of students that enrolled in College Now (CN) courses and then continued on to enroll in non-CN credit courses one year later increased 55% across the three years shown in the graph above. The College Now Program offers dual credit courses in partnership with Lane County high schools enabling high school students an opportunity to earn Lane credits for coursework completed in their high schools during their regular school day.
