
Key Benchmarks -- LANE Community College

Percent of County Population Enrolled (Age 18-years +) 2002-03 through 2006-2007



- ◆ In 2006-07, Lane enrolled 11.8% of the citizens of Lane county who were 18-years or older.
- ◆ During 2006-07, 88% of all Lane students were residents of Lane County, 7.5% were from outside the district, 2.5% were residents of border states, 0.9% were international students and less than 0.5 percent were out-of-state students. *
- Since 2002-03, on average, 11.6% of Lane County residents who were 18-years or older enrolled at Lane each year.

Analysis and Action: a) The total number of students enrolled at Lane during 2006-07 decreased 1.2% compared to 2005-06 (total annual unduplicated headcount increased 21% in 2005-06); b) the most recent estimate of Lane County population showed an increase of 1.3% from the prior year; c) based on findings from the National Community College Benchmarking Project, Lane's credit student market penetration rate and also its non-credit student market penetration rate both ranked between the 75th and 90th percentiles based on the 2005 data submission to the NCCBP. Lane has an enrollment goal of increasing total annual FTE by 1% in 2007-08.
