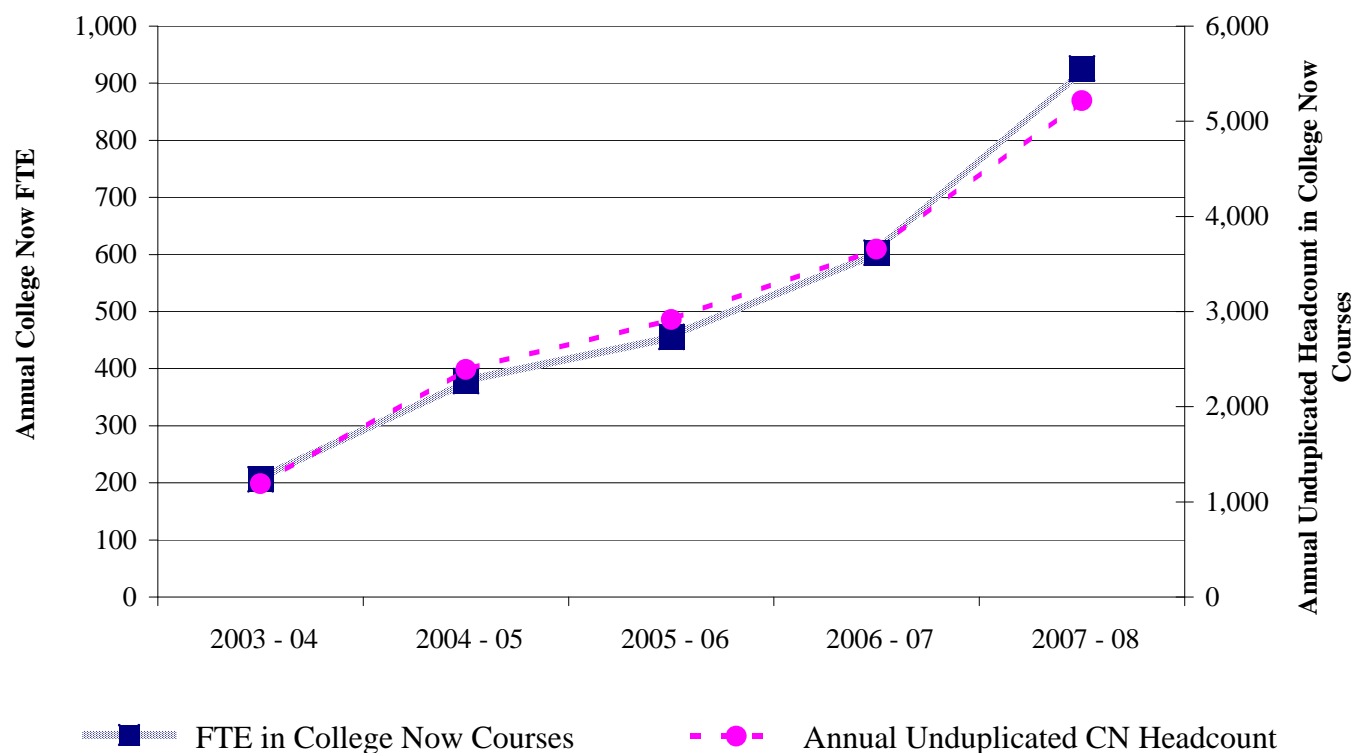


Key Benchmarks -- LANE Community College

College Now Enrollment



- ◆ During the 2007-08 academic year, 5,215 students were enrolled in College Now courses, yielding 925.9 FTE (compared to 3,657 students and 603.3 FTE in 2006-07).
- ◆ The number of students enrolled in College Now courses increased 42.6% from 2006-07 to 2007-08 (compared to an increase of 25% from '05-06 to '06-07).
- ◆ College Now FTE increased 53.5% from 2006-07 to 2007-08 (compared to 32.4% from '05-06 to '06-07).

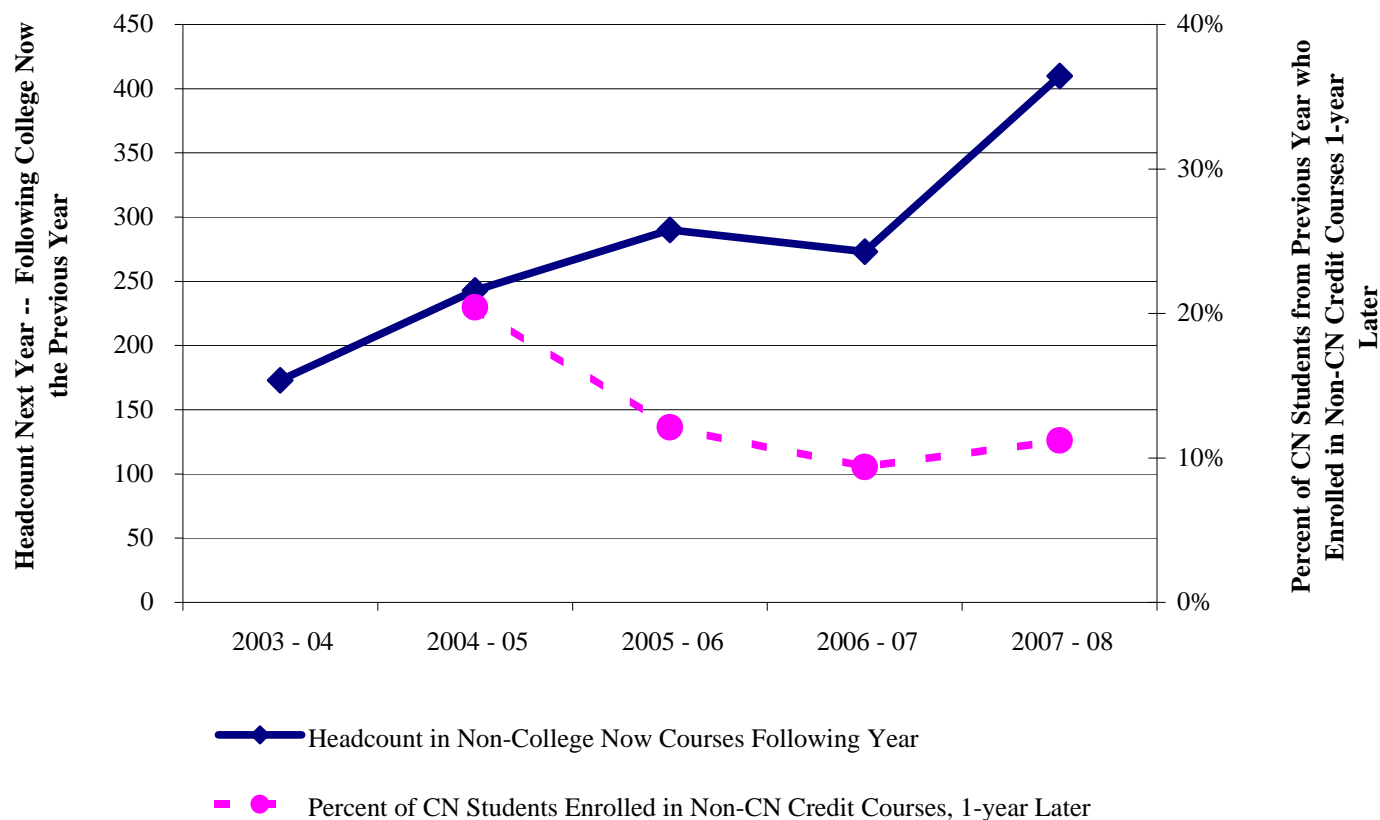
Analysis and Action: High school students enrolled in Lane's College Now Program earn lower division academic transfer and entry level career/technical course credits that also satisfy high school graduation requirements. College Now is part of a planned effort to achieve a learning continuum that starts in high school and extends through the second year at the community college, and if a student chooses, on to a four-year institution. College Now classes are taught by Lane-approved high school teachers using college course outlines and college textbooks.

Note: The Registration fee for College Now courses was discontinued at the start of the 2004-05 academic year.

College Now Students Enrolled in Credit Courses (not College Now) 1-year Later



- ◆ During the 2003-04 academic year, 1,190 students were enrolled in College Now courses. From those students, which could have included seniors, juniors and sophomores, 243 were enrolled in Lane credit courses (not College Now courses) one year later during the 2004-05 academic year and they accounted for 45 FTE. Those '04-05 students represented 20% of the '03-04 College Now enrollment.
- ◆ During the 2007-08 academic year, 5,215 students were enrolled in College Now courses. From those students, which could have included seniors, juniors and sophomores, 410 were enrolled in Lane credit courses (not College Now courses) one year later during the 2007-08 academic year and they accounted for 120 FTE. Those '07-08 students represented 11% of the '06-07 College Now enrollment.

Analysis and Action: The number of students that enrolled in College Now (CN) courses and then continued on to enroll in non-CN credit courses one year later increased 137% across the five years shown in the graph above, although the graph shows the percent of the prior year's CN enrollees has declined slightly. The College Now Program offers dual credit courses in partnership with Lane County high schools enabling high school students an opportunity to earn Lane credits for coursework done in their high schools during their regular school day.
