
## Key Benchmarks -- LANE Community College



College Now Students Enrolled in Non-College Now Courses One Year Later

• During the 2003-04 academic year, 1,190 students completed College Now courses. From that group of students (which could have included seniors, juniors and sophomores), 162 students were enrolled in Lane classes (not College Now courses) during summer and/or fall term 2004 which accounted for 51.4 FTE.

• During the 2006-07 academic year, 3,657 students completed College Now courses. From that group of students (which could have included seniors, juniors and sophomores), 340 students were enrolled in Lane classes (not College Now courses) during summer and/or fall term 2007 which accounted for 100.55 FTE.

Analysis and Action: The number of students that completed College Now (CN) courses and then continued on to enroll in non-CN credit courses increased over 100% across the four years shown in the graph above. The College Now Program offers dual credit courses in partnership with Lane County high schools enabling high school students an opportunity to earn Lane credits for coursework done in their high schools during their regular school day (find out more about College Now at ==> http://www.lanecc.edu/collhigh/index.htm).
