An overwhelming majority of respondents felt Lane was doing a good job. Comments are grouped as follows: positive experience, quality, jobs, instructors, personal success, services, class size and suggestions.

Positive Experience

Services

Also, enrollment services, academic services, career and employment services were valuable to me at the time.

My favorite lab was the Science lab - they had the nicest people and a comfortable environment. Having healthier/less expensive options for food would be nice. Because once you're at Lane there is no leaving for lunch. Especially if you take the bus (as I did) this made lunch expensive and inconvenient. Maybe have a less expensive daily special. I found if I only had a couple or few dollars for lunch, I was pretty much out of luck. The business/education counselor was wonderful! I saw her all the time - good communication and worth waiting in line to talk to.
- * Excellent tutor facilities, SRC, MRC and English writing help! Amazing people!
- * The Math and Science Resource Centers are invaluable. Having tutors available for help is wonderful. Faculty are knowledgeable, patient and kind. I had an overall great experience attaining my AAOT. In the Nursing program, the faculty again are wonderful. However, the space, ancient equipment, and some of the guidance counselors to get into the program need some updating.

Class Size
