- Nearly 39 percent (134) of all respondents and 61 percent (108) of career technical respondents had participated in Cooperative Education.
- Over 66 percent of all respondents who had participated in Cooperative Education indicated the *value* (Table 33) of their experience was "very good" and nearly 68 percent indicated the *relevance* of their experience (Table 34) was "very good."
- Approximately 85 percent of all respondents who had participated in Cooperative Education indicated both the value and relevance of their experiences were "good" or "very good."

Interpretation/Analysis

Most respondents found their cooperative work experiences to be rewarding, both professionally and personally.

Four themes emerged from the comments about the Cooperative Education experience. Cooperative Education


- Prepared students for real-life jobs.

- Provided an enjoyable experience.







Cooperative Education Comments

Former Lane students commented that their Cooperative Education experiences:

Prepared Respondents for Real-Life Jobs.

- * It was helpful seeing and working with actual legal documents vs what we did in class.
- * It was SO helpful and what a learning experience I had a more "realistic" idea and first-hand experience about my chosen field.
- * It was a positive experience for my MOA program because it gave me an opportunity to 'test' what I had learned and build my confidence in my abilities and accomplishments.
- * That got me out in the field and taught me what I needed to know and allowed me to put what I had been taught in class into a reality.
- * Very relevant good supervision and support. Instructor helped me get into a difficult department.
- * It was very valuable experience as far as letting me know what takes place in the world of graphic design outside school.

Opened Doors to Jobs.

- * My coop was a paid internship from which I transitioned to a regular benefited position.
- * I am still here working after graduating from Lane.
- * I got a job that I am still working three years later.
- * My co-op experience was responsible for me getting my job.
- * My co-op experience became my job. It worked out great for me.
- * The people I worked with were great. Co-op enabled me to get a job.
- * It was really good. I had a lot of choices in the area. I found the experience useful. Without that experience I wouldn't have my current job..

Helped both Lower Division Collegiate and Career Technical Respondents Find What Interested Them.

- * Mostly, the experience helped me discover what I did not want to do as a career which put what I did want to do in greater focus.
- * They really helped me understand what I wanted to do. I did a few of them.
- * I had a very good experience and it encouraged me to go on with my education.
- * Without this opportunity I would never have decided on what profession to obtain. This was very beneficial to me.
- * Co-op was a great way for me to figure out if this major is what I really wanted to do.
- * It was extremely helpful to get a feel for the field you would be working in and the types of people, the tasks and work that would be encountered.

Provided an Enjoyable Experience.

- * My co-op was really good. The school was good about checking in with me and making sure I was comfortable with the office I was placed in.
- * I enjoyed getting credit and hands on experience at the same time.
- * I really enjoyed it and would have liked to have done another co-op placement.
- * Co-op was excellent and I am doing another co-op just because I liked the first round so much.
- * Fantastic experience.

A small percentage of respondents expressed some disappointment and/or frustration with their Cooperative Education experiences as the following comments indicate:

- * With employers' demands for experience, I think there should be more time spent in Coop.
- * More of a variety was needed.
- * I did my co-op through my current job and that was a mistake. I didn't do what I was supposed to, so I didn't get a learning experience.

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
