
## Key Benchmarks -- LANE Community College

## Reasons for Attending Lane (New Credit Students): Fall Term



## Analysis and Action: For fall term 2010:

- > 47% of new Lane students enrolled in credit classes reported their main reason for attending Lane was preparation to transfer to a four-year institution; this is a decrease from 53% in fall 2006.
- > 30% of new students reported their main reason for attending Lane was to explore career or education options; this is an increase from 23% in fall 2006.

**Note**: Students report their main reason for attending while completing Lane's Admission Information Form (prior to their first registration). Beginning with fall 2006, new students complete that form on-line.

**Note:** The number of new credit students who did not report a main reason for attending Lane decreased 31% from fall '09 to fall '10 (from 293 students fall '09 to 203 fall '10).

**Data Source**: Lane's central student data system (RED-STUDENT -- QUIZ query "newreason"); Beginning fall 2003, these data obtained from Banner queries.
