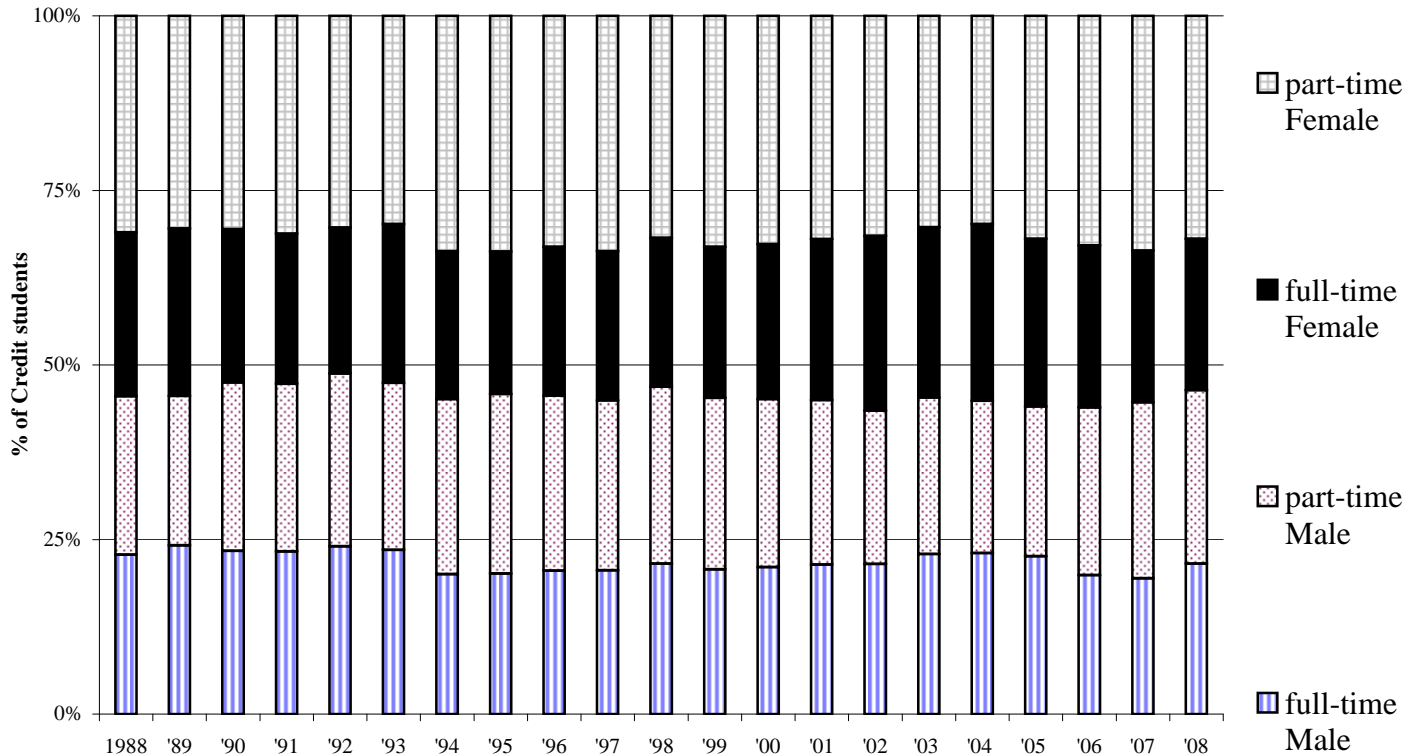


Key Benchmarks -- LANE Community College

Credit Students: Gender and Enrollment Status Fall Terms



Analysis and Action: For fall term 2008:

> 43.3% of all Lane credit students were enrolled full-time (12+ credits), compared to 46.3% fall 1988.

> 46.4% of credit students were male, compared to 45.5% fall 1988.

* 21.6% of credit students were males enrolled full-time (compared to 22.8% fall 1988).

> 53.6% of credit students were female, compared to 54.5% fall 1988.

* 21.7% of credit students were females enrolled full-time (compared to 23.5% fall 1988).

Comparing enrollment data for fall 2008 with fall 1988: 1) the total number of students enrolled in credit classes increased 73% since fall 1988 -- from 7,668 students fall '88 to 13,244 students fall '08; 2) the percent of males and females enrolled has not changed substantially; 3) the percent of part-time students has increased slightly. An important factor in the increase in part-time students is the growth in College Now enrollments.
