
Key Benchmarks -- LANE Community College

Gender and Enrollment Status (All Credit Students): Fall Term



Analysis and Action: For fall term 2009:

> 50% of all Lane credit students were enrolled full-time (12+ credits), compared to 46% fall 1988.

- > 48% of credit students were male, compared to 46% fall 1988.
 - * 25% of credit students were males enrolled full-time (compared to 23% fall 1988).
- > 52% of credit students were female, compared to 55% fall 1988.
 - * 25% of credit students were females enrolled full-time (compared to 24% fall 1988).

Comparing enrollment data for fall 2009 with fall 1988: 1) the total number of students enrolled in credit classes increased 74% - from 7,668 students fall '88 to 13,317 students fall '09; 2) the percent of males and females enrolled changed slightly; 3) the percent of students enrolled full-time increased slightly in fall '09.
