General Education

The purpose of general education at Lane is to foster wisdom through educational depth and breadth. How important are each of the following four core abilities and how effective overall was your coursework and training at Lane in helping you develop each core ability?

Communicate Effectively

• The percentage of respondents indicating communicating effectively as "important" or "very important" (97.8%) was higher than the percentage of respondents indicating that Lane's coursework/training in this area was "effective" or "very effective" (84.7%).

Think critically, solve problems effectively

• Nearly ninety-seven percent of all respondents indicated that thinking critically was "important" or "very important" while 85.4% indicated that Lane coursework/training in this area was "effective" or "very effective."

Understand the relationship between self and community; increase self-awareness and personal responsibility

• Over 88% of all respondents indicated that an understanding of the relationship between self and the community was "important" or "very important" while just under three-fourths (74.4%) indicated that Lane coursework/training in this area was "effective" or "very effective."

Explore academic disciplines of liberal arts, social sciences, and physical sciences

- The percentage of respondents indicating an exploration of academics as "important" or "very important" (75.9%) was fairly similar to the percentage of respondents indicating that Lane's coursework/training in this area was "effective" or "very effective" (77.7%).
- The percentage of respondents indicating an exploration of academics as "important" or "very important" was lower when compared to the percentages of respondents indicating "important" or "very important" for the other three core abilities above.

Interpretation/Analysis

The importance and effectiveness of each of Lane's four core abilities were analyzed separately according to completion status (graduates or no formal awards) and also by major grouping (lower division collegiate or career technical majors). In each of the four analyses, the results were substantially similar to the analysis of all respondents combined.


