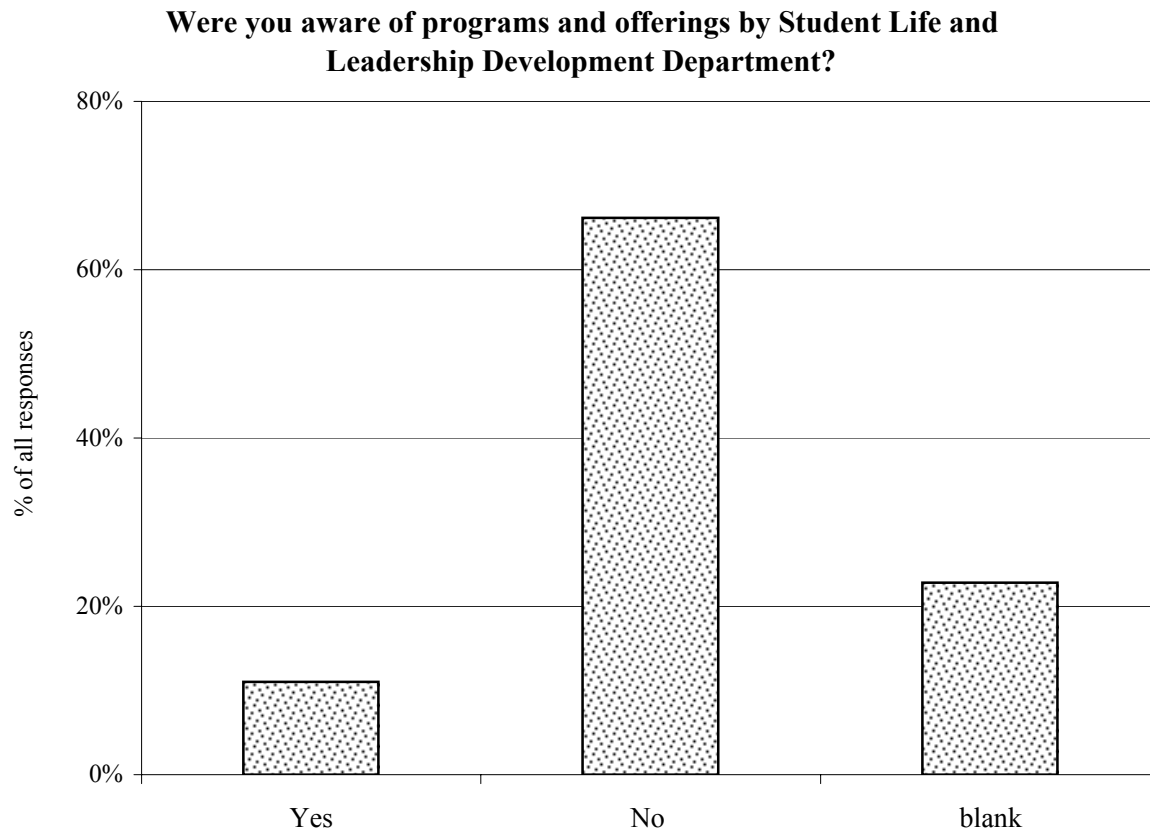
Question # : i

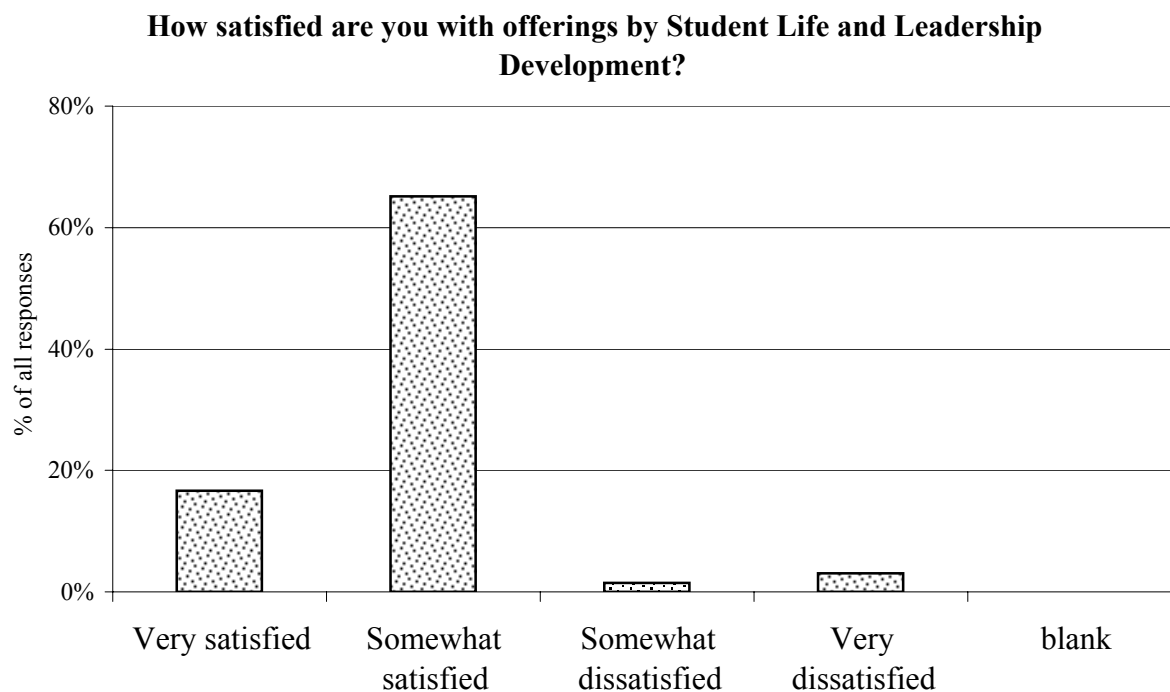
Question # : ii

Question description: **If you are aware of the Student Life and Leadership Development offerings, how satisfied are you with those offerings?**

Somewhat dissatisfied	1	1.5%	1.8%
Very dissatisfied	2	3.0%	3.5%

total	66	86%	100%

Example: 16.7% of all responses to this question were "Very satisfied" (N = 11).

Notes: "Valid Responses" exclude those not responding to the question. Only students who responded "yes" to Question i were included in this analysis.



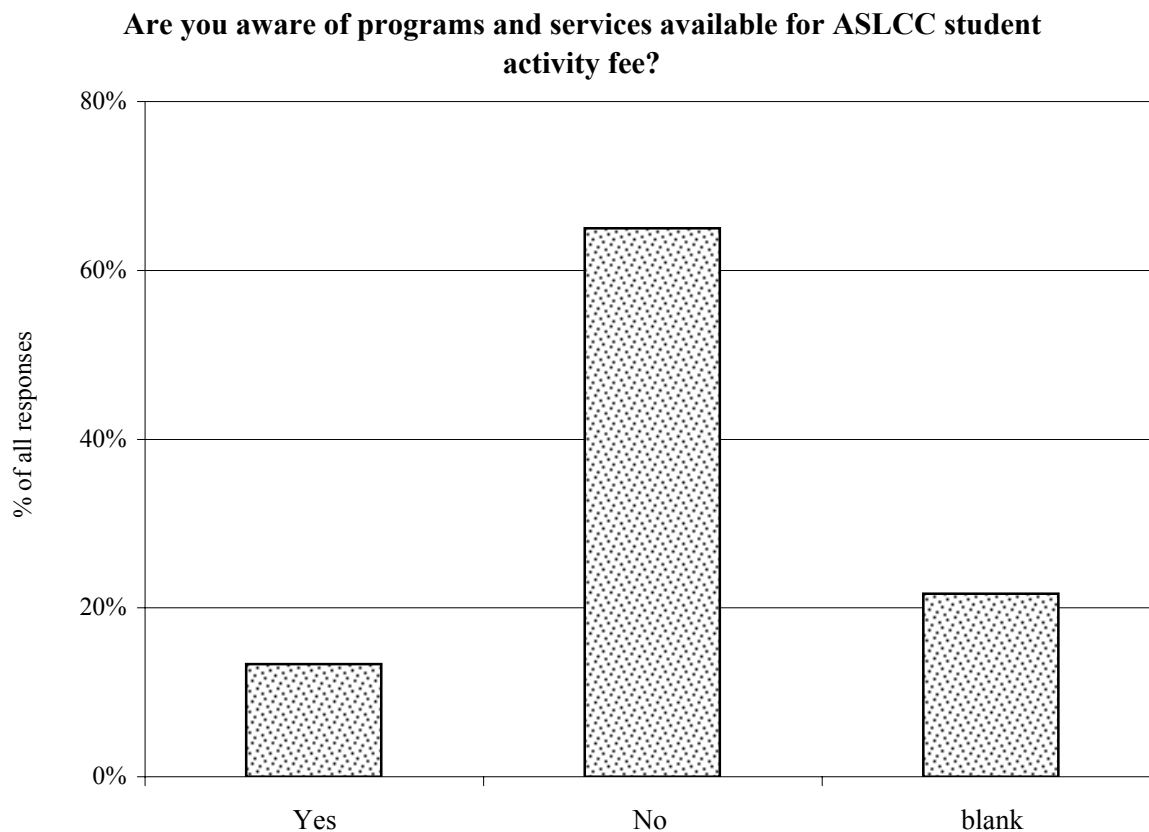
Question # : **iv**

Question description: **Are you aware of the programs and services available to Lane students who pay the mandatory ASLCC student activity fee (currently \$26.68 per term).**

Question description: **If you are aware of the programs and services available through the mandatory student activity fee, how satisfied are you with those programs and services?**

Somewhat satisfied	44	55.0%	59.5%
Somewhat dissatisfied	9	11.3%	12.2%
Very dissatisfied	11	13.8%	14.9%
blank	6	7.5%	na
total	80	100%	100%

Example: 12.5% of all responses to this question were "Very satisfied" (N = 10).

Notes: "Valid Responses" exclude those not responding to the question. Only students who responded "yes" to question iv were included in this analysis.
