# SCIENCE RESOURCE CENTER

**Purpose:** The Science Resource Center (SRC) houses services and materials to help you succeed in your sciences classes.

### **Services Offered:**

- Science Tutors are available throughout the operating hours of the Center. Tutor schedule information is available at the front desk.
- Instructors are encouraged to meet students in the Center and can offer small study sessions.
- Study alone or with a group using lab materials and study aids.
- Computers are available for science work only. Printing is limited to 15 sheets a day but can be extended for science projects.
- Specialized software is available, such as graphing programs, MATLAB and others.
- A microwave oven and hot water tap are available for refreshment, HOWEVER, no drinks or food is allowed near the computers.

### **Tuition Free Registration:**

To guarantee continued availability of these FREE services, please register for one of the CRN's posted in the SRC. You will need to ADD one of the listed CRN's to your schedule, but no fees or tuition are charged.

### **Study Spaces Available**

- Open Study: This is a place where group study happens. Models, large tables, and white boards are available for large groups, small groups and people who like to study in a crowd.
- Quiet Study: a room for individual, quiet study. Computers are available.
- Main Room:
  - Tutor area
  - Check-out desk where services, books, and other materials can be obtained.
  - Lab area with microscopes, computers, scales and other materials used in lab classes.
- Testing Rooms: Two testing rooms are available for students to take tests and quizzes left by instructors; to be coordinated with your Science instructor.
