- 1. Infusion project report by Jennifer: Things are looking good so far for the first training we have 10 people signed up and it will take place on Friday, Nov. 14th. Tammie, Susie and I will meet to work on a training evaluation form and complete the details of the training that Tammie organizing next Friday. The goal will be to have each person who is trained provide training for 10 more faculty, until the majority of our faculty are trained on how to infuse sustainability concepts into their curriculum.
- 2. **AAS, AS report by Margaret**: We have completed the NOI and now Margaret will fill out an online form. Susie, Larry and Mara agreed to work completing the outcomes mapping to courses that we currently have as well as online course from other institutions that may work. The goal is to have the program in place by Fall of 09, using as many of our existing classes at Lane for this program, if we do not have all of the classes we will develop new courses.
- 3. Green Stamp project: We need to bring it back to the two councils for approval. Larry will work with the councils to get this on the agenda. Susie and Larry will work on a format for presentation on this, including the newer idea of levels of green stamp based on the depth/amount of sustainability coverage within the class. The green stamp courses will be used to create the course of study.
- 4. **Course of study**-This will happen after we have the green stamp process approved. We can then have instructors apply for the green stamp approval and these courses will be listed in the course of study for our catalog.
